

Habakkuk 3:18 **yet I will ...**

HOW RESILIENT (ROBUST, DURABLE, TOUGH, ELASTIC) IS YOUR FAITH?

Can you say, "YET I WILL"

1., when IT FEELS AS IF GOD IS NOT ANSWERING YOU PRAYERS.

Habakkuk 1:2 How long, O LORD, must I call for help, but you do not listen? Or cry out to you, "Violence!" but you do not save?

2., when YOUR ARE FACED WITH HUMAN INJUSTICE.

Hab 1:3 Why do you make me look at injustice? Why do you tolerate wrong? Destruction and violence are before me; there is strife, and conflict abounds.

3., when GOD DOES NOT ANSWER YOUR PRAYER IN THE WAY YOU EXPECTED.

Hab 1:5-6 "Look at the nations and watch-- and be utterly amazed. For I am going to do something in your days that you would not believe, even if you were told. v6 I am raising up the Babylonians, that ruthless and impetuous people, who sweep across the whole earth to seize dwelling places not their own.

4., when GOD CHALLENGES YOUR UNDERSTANDING OF HIM.

Hab 1:12-13 O LORD, are you not from everlasting? My God, my Holy One, we will not die. O LORD, you have appointed them to execute judgment; O Rock, you have ordained them to punish. v13 Your eyes are too pure to look on evil; you cannot tolerate wrong. Why then do you tolerate the treacherous? Why are you silent while the wicked swallow up those more righteous than themselves?

5., when IT SEEEMS THE WICKED PROSPER.

Hab 2:9-10 "Woe to him who builds his realm by unjust gain to set his nest on high, to escape the clutches of ruin! v10 You have plotted the ruin of many peoples, shaming your own house and forfeiting your life.

6., when YOU HAVE NOTHING.

Hab 3:17 Though the fig tree does not bud and there are no grapes on the vines, though the olive crop fails and the fields produce no food, though there are no sheep in the pen and no cattle in the stalls,

You CAN say, “YET I WILL”

1., when YOU TRUST IN THE CHARACTER OF GOD.

Hab 3:18-19 yet I will rejoice in the LORD, I will be joyful in God my Savior. v19 The Sovereign LORD is my strength; he makes my feet like the feet of a deer, he enables me to go on the heights.

2., when YOU TRUST IN THE WORKS OF GOD.

Hab 3:2 LORD, I have heard of your fame; I stand in awe of your deeds, O LORD. Renew them in our day, in our time make them known; in wrath remember mercy.

3., when YOU TRUST IN THE TIMING OF GOD.

Hab 3:16 I heard and my heart pounded, my lips quivered at the sound; decay crept into my bones, and my legs trembled. Yet I will wait patiently for the day of calamity to come on the nation invading us.

4., when YOU LIVE BY FAITH.

Hab 2:2-4 Then the LORD replied: "Write down the revelation and make it plain on tablets so that a herald may run with it. v3 For the revelation awaits an appointed time; it speaks of the end and will not prove false. Though it lingers, wait for it; it will certainly come and will not delay. v4 "See, he is puffed up; his desires are not upright— ...

but the righteous will live by his faith

5., BECAUSE GOD HAS SAID “I WILL”.

Gen 17:8 The whole land of Canaan, where you are now an alien, I will give as an everlasting possession to you and your descendants after you; and I will be their God."

Exo 6:7 I will take you as my own people, and I will be your God. Then you will know that I am the LORD your God, who brought you out from under the yoke of the Egyptians.

Jer 7:23 but I gave them this command: Obey me, and I will be your God and you will be my people. Walk in all the ways I command you, that it may go well with you.

Jer 11:4 the terms I commanded your forefathers when I brought them out of Egypt, out of the iron-smelting furnace.' I said, 'Obey me and do everything I command you, and you will be my people, and I will be your God.

Jer 24:7 I will give them a heart to know me, that I am the LORD. They will be my people, and I will be their God, for they will return to me with all their heart.

Jer 30:22 "So you will be my people, and I will be your God.'"

Jer 31:33 "This is the covenant I will make with the house of Israel after that time," declares the LORD. "I will put my law in their minds and write it on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be my people.

Jer 32:38 They will be my people, and I will be their God.

Eze 11:20 Then they will follow my decrees and be careful to keep my laws. They will be my people, and I will be their God.

Eze 14:11 Then the people of Israel will no longer stray from me, nor will they defile themselves anymore with all their sins.

They will be my people, and I will be their God, declares the Sovereign LORD.'"

Eze 36:28 You will live in the land I gave your forefathers; you will be my people, and I will be your God.

Eze 37:23 They will no longer defile themselves with their idols and vile images or with any of their offenses, for I will save them from all their sinful backsliding, [2] and I will cleanse them. They will be my people, and I will be their God.

Eze 37:27 My dwelling place will be with them; I will be their God, and they will be my people.

2Co 6:16 What agreement is there between the temple of God and idols? For we are the temple of the living God. As God has said: "I will live with them and walk among them, and I will be their God, and they will be my people."^[3]

Heb 8:10 This is the covenant I will make with the house of Israel after that time, declares the Lord. I will put my laws in their minds and write them on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be my people.
